Bangladesh Technical Education Board developing competency-based assessment tools

Construction Industry Skills Council (CISC), in collaboration with Bangladesh Technical Education Board (BTEB) and Sudokkho, organised a three-day workshop at BTEB premises from 12th November to 14th November 2018.

The purpose of the workshop was to develop competency-based assessment tools for the occupations of Mason, Plumbing and Pipe Fitting and Electrical Installation and Maintenance at NTVQF level-1 training in the construction sector. The assessment tools will be used for national assessments conducted by BTEB.

Sudokkho builds upon the TVET reform agenda of the government of Bangladesh. The programme is executed by the [Directorate of Technical Education \(DTE\)](#), Government of Bangladesh. Palladium International is implementing the programme in consortium with SwissContact and British Council.



Sudokkho tests and scales-up market-driven, quality skills training systems within the readymade garments and construction sectors that will stimulate further investment in training by trainees, private training providers and employers. Sudokkho aims to ensure employment of 100,000 poor people, including women and disadvantaged populations, after successful completion of training through its partnerships with privately owned training service providers (PTPs) and industry-based training (IBT) initiatives.
